- **Goodbye** [unlike Spanish, it's never used for greetings]
- **Bye (bye)** [often heard twice]
- **Cheerio** [British English]
- **See you**
- **See you soon / tomorrow / on Monday / next week...**
- **Fare you well** [literary or poetic]
- **So long** [rather literary]
- **Good day** [Australian English]
- **Keep in touch** [very frequent in informal letters & emails]
- **I'll put the kettle on** [very British; most likely on the phone]
- **Good night** [Never use it to say 'hello'!]
- **Sleep tight** [often combined with the one above]
- **I'm off** [you say that when you're about to leave]
- **I'll be right back** [you announce that it won't take you long to come back]]
- **Take it easy**
- **Have a nice weekend!**
- **Have a good trip/journey.**
- **Don't call us, we'll call you** [after an unsuccessful job interview]
- **(I shall be) looking forward to seeing you.** [formal letters]
- **(I'll be) looking forward to your news.** [letters]
